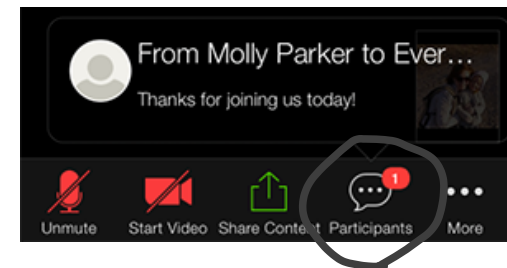
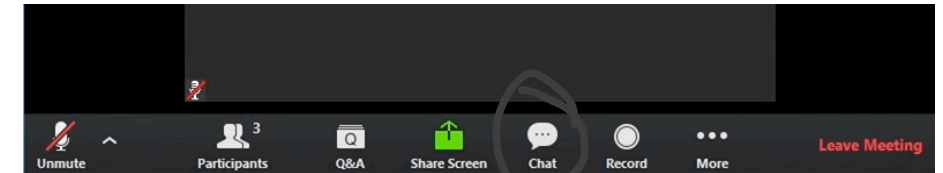

Hospital Council – Northern & Central California:

Supporting the Central Valley in Re-Opening & Preparing for the Next 12 Months

- Reopening requires testing, contact tracing, and community health practices – sustained efforts for the next year+
- Regional collaboration will be necessary to support and augment what the State and local public health agencies can do on their own
- Every community, county, hospital, medical provider, and health center must be supported and equipped to meet the challenge of COVID-19

Hospital Council – Northern & Central California:

Priorities for Collaboration

- **Testing** – *the complete pathway*
 - Consistent testing protocol
 - Adequate trained staff
 - PPE for testing
 - Swabs to collect, VTM
 - Courier process
 - Lab equipment, reagents & personnel
- **Contact Tracing**
- **Database of tests completed, supplies & needs**
- **Clear, Consistent Communication**
- **Advocacy for resources** – state, Federal, private
